OUR FIVE SENSES Activity Guide

A. Parent Child Game Activities

- 1. Take each Sense Card one by one and explain how each sense is important in our life.
- 2. Take out any play board, for example, the Sense of "Hearing" play board, break it into pieces and mix them.
- 3. First give the child the large card and explain how different activities are related to the Sense of Hearing.
- 4. Once the child has understood the concept ask hither to complete the puzzle by fixing the pieces at right places.
- 5. Repeat the above procedure with other boards.

B. Group Games

- 1. Take out all the boards from the box and separate all the pieces.
- 2. Divide the Five Senses cards (large center pieces) between the players.
- 3. Mix the other pieces and place them face up in the middle.
- 4. Each player in turn rolls the dice and collects his/her group piece by matching the dots printed on each card.
- 5. The first to collect all the pieces and join with the group together wins. Or
- 6. The play continues until all the pieces are matched.
- 7. Once all the players have completed their boards, ask them to explain each activity of their respective boards.

C. Picture Quiz

- 1. Each player is given a Senses play board.
- 2. All the play cards are placed face down.
- 3. The game leader picks up a card and describes the card in simple words but doesn't show it to the players.
- 4. To win the card, a player must explain why it belongs to his/her group.
- 5. The game continues until all Senses play boards are complete.

Everyone wins.

OR

The first player to complete his/her play board is the winner.
